UAR USE OF CHEMICAL WARFARE IN YEMEN




The UAR has employed the [redacted] toxic agent bomb in its Yemeni operation; this employment continues.



in a matrix; the massive quantities of agent released as the filling burns have been highly effective in causing Yemeni casualties. A second bomb may exist which uses another CW agent, possibly mustard, as a fill.



the chemical bomb developed by Major Salah Ibrahim Ghurab and used in Yemen in 1963 and as indicated above, in 1964. The bomb has a combustible filling composed of tear gas (chloroacetophenone)
