

1. Berliner Quarz Schmelze GmbH (23 April 1947)

Located in Pankow-Heinersdorf at Kaiser Wilhelmstrasse 48, this firm (currently employs only ten persons in the production of quartz equipment for submarines. Approximately 75% of its stock of material was confiscated and shipped to Russia soon after the Soviet occupation. At the present time, about 80% of the output is being purchased by the Russians, who are said to be interested in the enterprise and may buy it. Normal production is planned for autumn 1947, at which time the factory will be able to make quartz tubes up to 200 mm internal diameter.

2. Technical Section of Soviet Ministry for the Electrical Industry (1 May 1947)

This bureau, headed by Major Bryzin, is located in the former AEG transformer plant at Wilhelmshofstrasse 83-85, Berlin-Niederschöneweide. It is presently developing an electric motor destined for a Moscow rolling mill which produces iron blocks for agricultural machinery and tanks. Specifications for this motor, which is to serve as an alternator for a conveyor motor, include:

- Revolutions per minute: 50-120 (sic)
- Weight: approximately 120,000 kilograms
- Torque: 260 m/t (sic)
- HP: 6,000 or a maximum capacity of 18-20,000 HP.

3. Pertrix-Werke (13 May 1947)

This Berlin-Niederschöneweide firm, one of the leading wartime German producers of electric anodes and dry batteries for guided missiles, was dismantled in the autumn of 1945. Some of the equipment was returned in late 1946. At present, 240 German engineers and skilled workers are producing electric dry batteries for guided missiles. These batteries are made according to the German Army model; after testing, they are shipped in small quantities to a battery factory in Noginsk which is using some

of the former Pertrix machinery. A special laboratory at the Pertrix plant, headed by a Soviet engineer with the rank of major, employs only Russian workers. It is expected that some personnel, both German and Soviet, soon will be transferred to Noginsk.
