visit in early August 1962, he claims to have observed two very large
missiles being transported into the base located at Soroca [coord 943219,
San Cristobal Sheet 3584 II, Edition 1-AMS 1:50,000] Located there is
a very high hill with twin peaks and connecting saddle. stated
that the missiles were being brought into the base on large trailers
pulled by tracked vehicles. The trailers were supposedly all covered
and upon their arrival at the site a crane lifted the platform containing
the missile.
