This is a final response to your 25 October 2004 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for:

1. Office of Medical Services (OMS)/Oral History Program, Statement by John R. Tietjen, MD (Director, OMS, 1947-1974)
2. Office of Medical Services (OMS)/Oral History Program, Statement by Edward M. Gunn, MD (Chief, OMS Operations Division, circa 1953-1971)

We processed your request in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended, and the CIA Information Act, 50 U.S.C. § 431. Our processing included a search for records as described in our 28 January 2005 acceptance letter existing through the date of that letter.

We could not locate item #2.

We determined that item #1 is properly classified and must be denied in its entirety on the basis of FOIA exemptions (b)(3) and (b)(5). An explanation of exemptions is enclosed.

You have the right to appeal this decision by addressing your appeal to the Agency Release Panel within 45 days from the date of this letter, in my care. Should you choose to do this, please explain the basis of your appeal.
