On 26 January 1955 Cuban and Venezuelan investigators expressed dissatisfaction with the way the investigation of the assassination of former President REMON is being handled. There is evidence of confusion and lack of direction in the conduct of the investigation. The National Assembly investigating commission is not disclosing its findings.

 Comment. The Panamanian political situation remains unchanged. There are numerous rumors indicating a future shake-up in the Guardia Nacional (GN) and a possibility that the GN will merge with the Panama Secret Police (PSP). The investigating committee appointed by former President GUIZADO is no longer functioning.
