



On 14 January 1955 Ruben MIRO confessed his direct participation in the REMON assassination. MIRO implicated Juan E. JIMENEZ, who was placed under arrest at the Guardia Nacional (GN). Rodolfo San MALO and the son of President GUIZADO were also arrested.

Comments.
The GN has doubled its strength at highway check points and it is spot-checking cards. The GN is reportedly looking for Armulvistas (supporters of Arnulfo Arias).

MIRO's confession, which is not too convincing, could be a frame-up to remove GUIZADO. MIRO's implication of GUIZADO will probably mean political suicide for the former President even if he is never brought to trial.
