

The Central Committee of the Partido del Pueblo (PDP) met on January 1955 to discuss the REMON assassination. The Committee concluded that unusual security precautions will be necessary to prevent the implication of the PDP into the assassination, since the Party will be adversely affected. It was agreed that the size and length of Party meetings should be limited during the suspension of civil liberties in Panama. Currently there is no indication that the Party is involved in the assassination.
