



On December 1954 Colonel Carlos CASTILLO Armas, President of Guatemala, received an anonymous tip to the effect that he, President Jose REMON of Panama, and President Anastasio SMOZA of Nicaragua would be assassinated within a few days. An atmosphere of tension prevails in Guatemala, and added security measures have been taken to protect CASTILLO.
