MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Reporting on the Death of U.S. Priest James Carney

1. The following information is provided in an effort to keep the Committees updated on any new information on the case of Father Carney. A full report on the review of CIA activities in Honduras, generated by the recent Baltimore Sun series, will be briefed to the Committees when completed.

2. We recently received uncorroborated information relating two additional accounts of Father Carney's death 12 years ago, that was highlighted in the Baltimore Sun series.

3. One report [redacted] claim Father Carney was killed during the encounter between the military and the insurgent group. One of these sources says Carney was buried at the site of the conflict.

4. According to the second report:

- Father Carney was tortured to death by the Honduran military, and his body dismembered. Pieces of the body were buried in various places near Palestina in the Rio Patuca area.
- Carney had been captured, along with a group of insurgents, as the result of information provided by farmers in the area bordering Nicaragua.
- The military had distributed photographs of Carney, and leader of the insurgent group Jose Maria Reyes Mata, to farmers with instruction that they report the presence of Carney or Reyes in Honduran territory.

5. According to [redacted] the second report, this account of Carney's death was provided by the insurgents who were with Carney when he was captured. It is not clear whether these insurgents witnessed his death or simply heard about it.

substantiate it. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The assessment of the DI's Office of African and Latin American Analysis is that this is the least credible version of Father Carney's death, given its sourcing and lack of corroboration.

6. Other accounts indicate Father Carney died of starvation while traveling with the guerrillas or that he was captured and thrown from a helicopter by Honduran military personnel. We have been unable to substantiate definitively or rule out any of these accounts.
