Information from Beki.

GEORGES ANASTASIU, Mon Repos 28, Lausanne, Roumanian student of social sciences at the University of Lausanne, formerly studied radio engineering at the Eidgen. Technische Hochschule in Zurich. His father, Raoul Anastasiu is a high official at the Press Ministry in Bucarest, but father and son do not get along very well because the parents are divorced. Georges was in Belgrade for a short time in 1941 and in Bucarest this summer. He has been in Switzerland since 1940.

Beki knows Georges A. as a neighbor and says that he was formerly pro-Nazi but claims to have changed. He approach Beki and said he was very friendly with people working at the German Consulate in Lausanne among whom he mentioned a Horst von Gabriel, assistant to the chief whose initials he gave as H.C.D., and with a fellow named Völkle, Ortsgruppenführer.

Beki believes that Georges A. might be able to furnish us with valuable information regarding the activities of the various members of the German Consulate in Lausanne. However, Georges A. wants to be paid for it and the question arises if we are interested in this type of information. It is of course understood that Beki did not tell Georges A. for whom this information is intended.
