Information from BEKI.

1. Beki suggests that the Yougoslav Minister in Bern be consulted regarding the distribution of money collected by the Yougoslavs in America for the Yougoslav refugees in Switzerland.
2. Word has just been received that Madame ALTAROS has been released from prison in Milan and has left for Zagreb. This information should be passed on to COK now in Cairo.
3. Beki is very anxious to know if we ever received the report from Wood in Madrid regarding names and addresses of persons to be contacted for a clandestine passage through France. These names were supposed to have been furnished to Wood by a Yougoslav who passed through France about 3 months ago (see his name in Beki's file).
4. When would it be convenient for you to see any two of the following Yougoslav army men now interned at Vevey. I believe it was suggested at the last meeting that you would see the two brothers first. Attached are the report compiled by these army men.
