

October 27, 1944

Report on events of October 26, 1944.

I arrived at 21.30 at the Frontier Post N. 2, as per instructions received, and together with the guard went to "Cancello del Pratello" where I arrived exactly at 11.15; we stopped at about 20 m. from the net. At about 11.45 I heard the first signal, on which we had agreed (a screech-owl), of Maro, and in spite of the fact that the German patrol had not yet passed, went to the ~~XXXXX~~ ~~XXXXXX~~ meeting place. Then I called again, but had no answer. After about half an hour I went back to the starting point, and at about 1 I heard the signal from a long distance, and towards north. I went in that direction together with the guard, walking along the net, tried in vain to call again, and then went to the "Cancello" where I remained until about 2 a.m.

Probably Maro was afraid because the German patrol had not passed, and surely he left the place before I did, as before I came back I called in all possible ways.

I hope S. Ciro will find a means of letting me know something to-day.
