My dear Major

Alteno has brought us your first courier which has seemed to us good material, and we are willing to continue with the service to see how it goes. I am sending with him today one hundred thousand lire and when he comes again on Saturday will send the rest if this passage works well. Will you send back the receipt of this money, and send me an estimate on how much this service should cost per month.

As for the radio send us immediately the wave length and frequencies with call signals and code that you will use. We have a radio here, and we will reply with "Ireland" on same wave length to let you know that we are receiving. Give us hours of your emission. Please send this by Saturday so we can commence at once our service.

We are most interested in troop movements and location with number of division and details. Let this be the main point of your work. Leave partisan activity and sabotage aside, and concentrate entirely on military information.
