

Survey of CIA (SPG?)

Mr. Robert Blum, CIA Survey (tel) - Informed Director that he had talked to Allen Dulles who plans to come to Washington Thursday night and work with Group on Friday and Saturday. He will come to see Director with Mr. Dulles on Friday morning; Mr. Blum will telephone beforehand.

Mr. Gaynor, SO (tel) - Re Cong. Charles E. Potter, Michigan. (Was a Captain in 28th Inf. Div. in last war; lost both legs; is anxious to do something to further intelligence; does not know what he can do but desires to help.) Mr. Gaynor became acquainted with the Congressman through his brother who was in the same unit. Col. Galloway felt that some good might result from contacting the Congressman and Director desires to do so. Mr. Gaynor extended Cong. Potter's invitation to Director for lunch on Tues., 30 Mar, House Office Bldg., 11:45. Mr. Richard expressed Director's regrets to Mr. Gaynor and requested that he attempt to set up another date for lunch with the Congressman. (Wed., 31st)
