I have received responses from CIA components regarding searches made by them in response to the request, dated 26 June 1992, from Deputy Assistant Attorney General Mark Richard, for information on allegations that Commodity Credit Corporation guaranteed U.S. agricultural commodities destined for Iraq were diverted to Yugoslavia, Bulgaria, the former Soviet Union or other Soviet Bloc countries in apparent barter transactions for military equipment. You asked for any information regarding possible shipments, parties involved, and other relevant details.

CIA files contain no responsive records regarding the activities that were the subject of the allegations in your 26 June letter.
