James Monnier Simon, Jr. (Jim) was nominated by the President to his current position in October 1998. Following a hearing before the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence and confirmation by the Senate on 2 March, Mr. Simon was sworn in by DCI Tenet on 4 March 1999.

Mr. Simon was commissioned in the US Army in 1969, retiring in 1997 from the active reserve. He is a graduate of the Military Intelligence Officers Advanced Course, the Command and General Staff College, and has completed the Security Management Course from the National War College.

Mr. Simon has a B.A. in political science from The University of Alabama and a M.A. in international relations from the University of Southern California (USC). He held both Herman and Earhart fellowships while pursuing a Ph.D. at USC with emphasis in national security, bureaucracy, Soviet studies, and Marxism-Leninism.

He left USC before completing his dissertation and joined the CIA in 1975 through its Career Training Program. He served briefly in the clandestine service before joining the Directorate of Intelligence's Office of Strategic Research as a military analyst specializing in tactics and doctrine as well as Soviet military strategy, doctrine, and plans. From 1986 to 1990 he was in charge of the Intelligence Community organization responsible for tasking the Imagery Constellation. In 1990, he was assigned as the Senior Intel Rep to the US delegation for the CFE Treaty in Vienna where he was principal negotiator for the Treaty's information exchange protocol. After ratification in 1991, Mr. Simon was reassigned as chief of the Community's facility responsible for the preparation, debriefing, and reporting of information gained by arms control inspection teams throughout Europe. In 1993, Mr. Simon became a division chief in the CIA's Office of European Analysis and in 1996

was named to lead CIA's Collection Requirements and Evaluation Staff.
