




UNITED KINGDOM: BOMBS EXPLODE NEAR CLAPHAM JUNCTION ON BRITAIN'S BUSIEST RAILWAY LINES AFTER AUTHORITIES RECEIVE WARNING CALLS. [REDACTED]

TURKEY: KURDISH WORKER'S PARTY (PKK) TERRORISTS FIREBOMB A STORE IN ISTANBUL KILLING 11 CIVILIANS. []

TURKEY: A TURKISH AIRLINE OFFICE IS DAMAGED IN ONE OF SEVERAL DEV SOL BOMBINGS IN AND AROUND ISTANBUL. []

26 DECEMBER

TURKEY: PKK TERRORISTS SABOTAGE A TURKISH PETROLEUM CORPORATION OIL WELL, SETTING THE WELL AND FOUR VEHICLES ON FIRE IN BATMAN. []

SPAIN: TWO EXPLOSIVE DEVICES ARE LOCATED AND DEACTIVATED ON THE RAILWAY LINE CONNECTING MADRID WITH SEVILLA AT THE TOWN OF LORA DEL RIO CAPPROX. THE BASQUE FATHERLAND AND LIBERTY (ETA) IS SUSPECTED. []

SPAIN: A SMALL EXPLOSIVE DEVICE DETONATES ON AN OUTER WALL SURROUNDING THE HOTEL ALFONSO XIII IN SEVILLA, CAUSING MATERIAL DAMAGE. ETA IS SUSPECTED. []

28 DECEMBER

SPAIN: AUTHORITIES DEACTIVATE AN EXPLOSIVE DEVICE PLACED ON A WINDOWSILL OF A BRANCH OF THE BANK OF EUROPE IN THE CENTER OF SEVILLA. []

30 DECEMBER

TURKEY: A NEW GROUP, PEOPLE'S LIBERATION FORCES, BOMBS THE SWISS HOTEL IN ISTANBUL INJURING A MAN, AND THE ANKARA OFFICE OF HURRIYET, A TURKISH DAILY NEWSPAPER, INJURING A SECOND MAN. []

SPAIN: TWO SUSPECTED ETA MEMBERS MANAGE TO STEAL 500 BLANK LICENSE PLATES AND A PLATE IMPRINTING MACHINE. THE SUSPECTS ALLEGEDLY GAINED ACCESS TO THE PLATES BY IDENTIFYING THEMSELVES AS POLICEMEN, USING THE PRETEXT OF CONDUCTING AN INSPECTION OF THE PLATES. []

31 DECEMBER

NORTHERN IRELAND: SEVERAL PERSONS ARE INJURED AND SEVERAL STORES DAMAGED IN A SERIES OF BOMBING ATTACKS THROUGHOUT NORTHERN IRELAND. []

3 JANUARY

NORTHERN IRELAND: THE ULSTER VOLUNTEER FORCE (UVF) ASSASSINATES A CATHOLIC MAN AND INJURES HIS 70-YEAR-OLD UNCLE AND A 10-YEAR-OLD

GIRL IN AN ATTACK IN COUNTY TYRONE. []

4 JANUARY

TURKEY: A GENDARME MAJOR AND A TERRORIST ARE KILLED IN A CLASH IN KAHRAMANMARAS DISTRICT. []

NETHERLANDS: A NEW GROUP, ACTION FRONT NATIONALISTIC NETHERLANDS, BOMBS THE DUTCH IMMIGRATION OFFICE IN THE HAGUE. []

GERMANY: THE HANSEATIC HIGHER REGIONAL COURT GRANTS RED ARMY FACTION (RAF) MEMBER, HOLGER DEIKE, PAROLE FROM IMPRISONMENT ON CERTAIN CONDITIONS, FOLLOWING HIS TWO YEARS IN CUSTODY. []

5 JANUARY

NORTHERN IRELAND: IN TWO SEPARATE INCIDENTS, PIRA BOMBS INJURE 13 PERSONS AND DAMAGE SEVERAL BUILDINGS IN AND AROUND BELFAST. []

ITALY: A BOMB COMPOSED OF PLASTIC EXPLOSIVES DESTROYS A 1-METER SECTION OF A RAIL LINE NEAR THE TOWN OF SURBO, BETWEEN LECCE AND BRINDISI. CLAIMS FOR THE BOMBING WERE MADE BY THE ARMED FALANGE AND THE RED BRIGADES TERRORIST GROUPS. []

6 JANUARY

NORTHERN IRELAND: A 500-POUND PIRA BOMB, PLACED INSIDE A HIGHJACKED POST OFFICE VAN, EXPLODES OUTSIDE THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE NORTHERN IRELAND POLICE AUTHORITY IN BELFAST. []

IRELAND: PIRA MEMBERS ROB THE CASH HOLDING CENTER OF THE ALLIED IRISH BANK IN WATERFORD, IRELAND, STEALING THE LARGEST AMOUNT OF MONEY EVER TAKEN IN AN IRISH BANK ROBBERY. []

SPAIN: AUTHORITIES ARREST THREE ALLEGED ETA DONOSTI COMMANDO MEMBERS IN SAN SEBASTIAN. []

8 JANUARY


SPAIN: ONE SPANISH AIR FORCE OFFICER IS SHOT AND KILLED, AND TWO ARE WOUNDED BY TWO GUNMEN IN DOWNTOWN BARCELONA. THE BASQUE FATHERLAND AND LIBERTY (ETA) IS SUSPECTED. []

9 JANUARY

CORSICA: THE NATIONAL LIBERATION FRONT OF CORSICA (FLNC) ASSASSINATES DOMINIQUE ROSSI, A FORMER ASSOCIATE, WHO WAS SCHEDULED TO CAMPAIGN FOR A SEAT IN UPCOMING MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS. []

NORTHERN IRELAND: PIRA MEMBERS DETONATE A CAR BOMB OUTSIDE THE LONDONDERRY ROYAL ULSTER CONSTABULARY (RUC) HEADQUARTERS, INJURING A SOLDIER AND SEVERAL CIVILIANS AND DAMAGING SEVERAL SHOPS AND BUSINESSES. []

10 JANUARY



UNITED KINGDOM: A PIRA BOMB DETONATES IN THE WHITEHALL AREA NEAR NO. 10 DOWNING STREET IN LONDON.

NORTHERN IRELAND: PIRA BOMBS DAMAGE SEVERAL BUSINESSES IN COUNTY ANTRIM.

11 JANUARY

TURKEY: PKK MEMBERS KIDNAP AND EXECUTE FOUR VILLAGE GUARDS IN DIYARBAKIR.

YUGOSLAVIA: TWO BOMBS ARE TOSSED FROM A PASSING CAR IN SEPARATE LOCATIONS IN LOZNICA INJURING FIVE PEOPLE.

12 JANUARY

TURKEY: TERRORISTS SHOOT AND KILL A UNIVERSITY STUDENT IN DIYARBAKIR.

NORTHERN IRELAND: TERRORISTS ATTEMPTING TO HIJACK A CAR THROW A BRICK THROUGH THE WINDOW, STRIKING AND KILLING A MAN IN NORTH BELFAST.

GREECE: TWO LOW-YIELD EXPLOSIVE DEVICES DETONATE SIMULTANEOUSLY IN THE ENTRYWAYS OF TWO GERMAN ELECTRONICS COMPANIES IN THESSALONIKI. PEOPLES REVOLT CLAIMED RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ATTACK.

14 JANUARY

SPAIN: A SPANISH NATIONAL POLICEMAN IS SHOT AND KILLED BY TWO GUNMEN IN BILBAO, VIZCAYA. ETA IS SUSPECTED.

MIDDLE EAST

12 JANUARY

LEBANON: A LARGE BOMB EXPLODES IN SOUTHERN LEBANON, CAUSING NO INJURIES.

14 JANUARY

WEST BANK: ARMED ASSAILANTS ATTACK AN ISRAELI BUS IN RAMALLAH.



LEBANON: TWO UNKNOWN GUNMEN ASSASSINATE LEBANESE AUTHOR MUSTAFA JIHA.

19 JANUARY

ALGERIA: A BOMB EXPLODES AT A POLICE STATION IN ALGIERS, CAUSING NO CASUALTIES.

20 JANUARY



EGYPT: POLICE ARREST FIVE EXTREMISTS FOR KILLING TWO SURVEY ENGINEERS. [REDACTED]

26 JANUARY

WEST BANK: MASKED MEN KILL FOUR ALLEGED COLLABORATORS IN THE WEST BANK. [REDACTED]

27 JANUARY

WEST BANK: POLICE ARREST A SUSPECT HURT IN AN EXPLOSION AT A RELIGIOUS SITE IN HEBRON. [REDACTED]

LATIN AMERICA

30 DECEMBER

COLOMBIA: FOUR NATIONAL LIBERATION ARMY MEMBERS DIED IN A FAILED ATTEMPT TO ATTACK THE BARRANQUILLA AIR FORCE BASE. THE FOUR WERE FLEEING WHEN ONE OF THEIR EXPLOSIVE DEVICES ACCIDENTLY DETONATED, DESTROYING THE CAR IN WHICH THEY WERE RIDING. [REDACTED]

5 JANUARY

PERU: SENDERO LUMINOSO (SL) TERRORISTS EXECUTE A SUSPECTED GOVERNMENT INFORMER BY STRAPPING 2 KILOGRAMS OF DYNAMITE TO THE VICTIM, THEN DETONATING THE CHARGE. [REDACTED]

PERU: SIXTEEN SENDERO LUMINOSO MEMBERS ESCAPE FROM SANTIAGO DE CHUCO PRISON. THE TERRORISTS, ALONG WITH JAILED EX-PRISON DIRECTOR CESAR FERNANDEZ, ESCAPED THROUGH A 40-METER TUNNEL. [REDACTED]

9 JANUARY

PANAMA: A BOMB EXPLODES ON THE FOURTH FLOOR OF THE PLANNING MINISTRY BUILDING. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED. [REDACTED]

10 JANUARY

CHILE: AUTHORITIES ARREST BERNARDO ACEVEDO LAGOS, A TOP LAUTARO YOUTH MOVEMENT (MJL) LEADER. [REDACTED]

PERU: TUPAC AMARU REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENT (MRTA) TERRORISTS BOMB THE ECUADORAN EMBASSY, WOUNDING FIVE POLICEMEN. THE ATTACK WAS TO PROTEST A BORDER-DISPUTE SETTling TRIP TO ECUADOR BY PRESIDENT FUJIMORI. [REDACTED]

COLOMBIA: THE NATIONAL LIBERATION ARMY (ELN) ATTACKED THE CANO-LIMON-COVENAS PIPELINE NEAR PAILITAS. MORE THAN 10,000 BARRELS OF CRUDE WERE SPILLED AS A RESULT. [REDACTED]

12 JANUARY

PERU: COMMUNITY ORGANIZER AND URBAN PATROL LEADER ERNESTO LOPEZ DE

LA CRUZ IS KILLED BY SL TERRORISTS. [REDACTED]

CHILE: A CHILD IS INJURED DURING A ROBBERY OF THE CREDIT AND INVESTMENT BANK IN VALDIVIA. THE MJL CLAIMED RESPONSIBILITY. [REDACTED]

17 JANUARY

PANAMA: POLICE DEACTIVATE A TIME BOMB FOUND IN THE BASEMENT OF A 7-ELEVEN IN EL DARADO. [REDACTED]

18 JANUARY

PERU: THE HUANCAYO REGIONAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE FISHERIES MINISTRY AND HIS BODYGUARD ARE KILLED BY SL MEMBERS. [REDACTED]

PERU: SL TERRORISTS KILL FIVE MEMBERS OF AN AYACUCHO FAMILY AND TWO FRIENDS WHO TRIED TO PROTECT THEM. [REDACTED]

COLOMBIA: A US CITIZEN MINING ENGINEER IS KIDNAPPED BY MEMBERS OF THE REVOLUTIONARY ARMED FORCES (FARC) NEAR THE TOWN OF BAGRE, ANTIPIA DEPARTMENT. HE WAS RELEASED UNHARMED ON 25 JANUARY. [REDACTED]

PHILIPPINES: THREE ARMED MEN KIDNAP A US BUSINESSMAN AS HE ARRIVES AT HIS OFFICE PARKING LOT IN THE MAKATI DISTRICT OF MANILA. [REDACTED]

INDIA: A BOMB EXPLODES IN A BUSY BAZAAR IN SAMANA TOWN, PATILAL DISTRICT, PUNJAB, KILLING SIX PERSONS AND INJURING 20. [REDACTED]

18 JANUARY

PAKISTAN: A BOMB EXPLODES PREMATURELY IN A COMMERCIAL DISTRICT IN CENTRAL RAWALPINDI, KILLING THE PAKISTANI NATIONAL CARRYING IT AND



INJURING EIGHT BYSTANDERS.

19 JANUARY

PHILIPPINES: NEW PEOPLE'S ARMY REBELS AMBUSH A PASSENGER JEEPNEY NEAR BARANGAY LIGAO, ALBAY PROVINCE, KILLING THREE PERSONS, INCLUDING ONE CIVILIAN.

23 JANUARY

INDIA: PUNJABI MILITANTS ATTACK A BUS CARRYING SUPPORTERS OF THE HINDU BHARATIYA JANATA PARTY, KILLING AT LEAST THREE PASSENGERS. THE BUS WAS PART OF AN ANTI-SEPARATIST MOTORCADE TRAVELING TOWARD SRINAGAR, IN PREDOMINANTLY MUSLIM JAMMU AND KASHMIR STATE.

24 JANUARY

INDIA: A BOMB EXPLODES IN THE OFFICE OF THE REGIONAL POLICE CHIEF IN SRINAGAR DURING A MEETING ON SECURITY FOR THE HINDU ANTISEPARATIST MOTORCADE, KILLING ONE PERSON AND INJURING AT LEAST SEVEN. KASHMIRI MILITANTS ARE BELIEVED RESPONSIBLE.

26 JANUARY

SRI LANKA: A LANDMINE EXPLODES UNDER A BUS IN AMPARAI DISTRICT, KILLING EIGHT CIVILIANS AND INJURING 17. ONE AIRMAN WAS KILLED AND SEVEN WOUNDED BY LTTE MILITANTS WHEN A IN AIR FORCE PATROL RUSHED TO THE SCENE.

28 JANUARY

CAMBODIA: AN UNIDENTIFIED GUNMAN ON A PASSING MOTORCYCLE SHOOTS AND INJURES A PROMINENT OPPOSITION POLITICAL ACTIVIST DRIVING HIS CAR IN PHNOM PENH.

29 JANUARY

INDIA: A BOMB EXPLODES INSIDE A BUS IN NEW DELHI, KILLING ONE PERSON AND INJURING AT LEAST 25.

30 JANUARY


SRI LANKA: BOMBS RIGGED TO TWO BICYCLES EXPLODE IN A CROWDED BAZAAR IN THE MUSLIM TOWNSHIP OF KARTHANKUDY, KILLING TWO PERSONS AND INJURING EIGHT. THE LTTE IS BELIEVED RESPONSIBLE.

SOUTH AFRICA: A PETROL BOMB EXPLOSION DESTROYS THE HOME OF AN AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS (ANC) MEMBER IN SEBOKENG TOWNSHIP.

SOUTH AFRICA: TWO POLICEMEN ARE SHOT AND KILLED IN THE EAST RAND TOWNSHIP. TWO MEN HAVE BEEN ARRESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE DEATHS.
