

Dear Coordinator,

Under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. subsection 552, I am requesting information or records on intelligence reports relating to terrorism or the suspicion of terrorism. These reports should include information on the activities of a terrorist or terrorist group, which appear suspicious and possibly related to an impending incident. A good example of a document that fits this description is the document entitled "Bin Ladin Preparing to Hijack US Aircraft and Other Attacks," case number EB-2004-00029, which is posted in the FOIA Electronic Reading Room on the CIA website. I am interested in all documents of this sort that may not have been posted in the FOIA Reading Room, but to which I may still be granted access in full or in part. The date of the information contained in the documents is not important to me, but rather I am concerned with the intelligence information itself and the format of the document.

If possible, I would like these documents in some sort of text format. I have been able to view several documents from the FOIA Reading Room but all those documents have been in image format (*.gif files). For my purposes, some type of text version (plain text, Microsoft Word format, searchable PDF, etc.) would be optimal. However if this is impossible, I would still be interested in obtaining these files in *.gif format.

This information will be used for commercial purposes (for an internal R&D project with Lockheed Martin). If there are any fees associated with searching for, reviewing, or copying the records, please inform me before you task my request.

If you deny all or any part of this request, please cite each specific exemption you think justifies your refusal to release the information and notify me of appeal procedures available under the law.

Also, an estimation of the amount of time necessary to process my request along with a ballpark estimate of the number of relevant articles that can be obtained would be much appreciated.
