Social Christian Party, he served in Congress during the late 1950s. Ugueto worked at the Central Bank during 1962-63 and was a director of the Bank of Commerce from 1967 to 1969. During 1969-70 he was director general of the Finance Ministry, and he served concurrently as director and acting president of the Public Administration Commission in Caracas. Ugueto was Minister-Counselor and chief financial officer of the Embassy in Washington during 1970-74. Concurrently, he was active in international financial affairs as an executive director of the International Monetary Fund and as a governor of the Inter-American Development Bank. Before becoming Finance Minister he was general manager of the Seguros Orinoco insurance company. [REDACTED]
