

SUBJECT: Joint Medical Intelligence Committee


1. On 31 March,  reported to me on his discussions with the Department of State regarding what State's position would be if a proposal were made to the IAC by one of the service agencies for establishment of a formal inter-agency medical intelligence committee under IAC aegis. The matter had been discussed with Mr. T. M. Nordbeck and with Mr. H. Wiedermann, the former of whom had taken the matter up with Fischer Howe. State feels that it is a mistake to set up a series of formal independent inter-agency committees under the IAC; that it would be better to simply get IAC blessing for informal working groups. However, if a proposal is made to the IAC for such a medical committee, State Department will not oppose it.
