SUBJECT: Status of SGOBZOKOV's POA.

It seems that subject did not have a CSA. Under the circumstances it seems that it is advisable to process this POA request. Later on, CSA could be requested on Subject. Presently there is a memo from SO re "Subject's meeting with unknown representative from Washington" also and unidentified source alleged that Subject is a Soviet agent. An attachment to the original SO memo is missing. [ ] put a tracer on this and is requesting a copy of the attachment which explains the alleged accusations. After [ ] reviews the attachments [ ] will [ ] about the POA status. John will notify us what action he will take after reviewing the [ ] attachments to SO memo. Thus far the results are inconclusive and still no POA was initiated.

24 January 1957

A [ ] in SO forwarded the results of the SO check to CI/OA today. SGOBZOKOV previously had a PCSA processing but in light of the AERBARDY program this Request was closed and in lieu of this the POA was processed and took precedence. SGOBZOKOV never had a CSA.
