This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act.

I request copies of the two following documents that were produced as official histories of significant intelligence production activities in the Directorate of Intelligence. Both of the documents were produced by the Office of Basic and Geographic Intelligence. The production time frame was in the 1960's -- probably in the late 1960's, but possibly spilling over into the early 1970's.

1) The National Intelligence Survey (NIS) Program.

2) The Special Intelligence Graphic (SIG) Program. An alternate designation was the Intelligence Map Program (IMP).

These materials were originally classified SECRET, but are now eligible for complete declassification.

I also request copies of any other items pertaining to these two programs that may have already been declassified. Of particular interest would be documents pertaining to the continuation, reduction, modification, or termination of either program.

These materials are needed to support my ongoing research and analysis on the lessons of these two programs relative to the current worldwide challenges and responsibilities of the Intelligence Community. Obviously, an expeditious response to this request would significantly facilitate this research and publication effort.
