SUBJECT: Mrs. Eolene F. VINCENT - Recommendation for Promotion

1. Mrs. Eolene F. VINCENT, GS-8, has specialized in her Agency career (dating from November 1957) in intelligence analysis and counter-intelligence analysis, and has been assigned to this [redacted] as [redacted] Analyst since August 1958.
