
: Personnel Concerned.

1. Technical Sergeant Robert E. Lang, 33455619, is directed to proceed by rail, on or about May 5, 1943, from Washington, D.C. to Boston, Mass., thence to Potter Place, N.H., thence to White River Junction, Vt., thence to New York City, N.Y., thence to Columbus, Ohio, thence to Delaware, Ohio, thence to Pittsburgh, Pa., on temporary duty of approximately twelve (12) days duration, for the purpose of performing duty in connection with S activities. Upon completion of this period of temporary duty soldier will return to his proper station in Washington, D.C. FD 34 P 434-02 A 25-23. QNT. TDN.

2. It being impracticable for the government to furnish cooking facilities for rations and it having been determined that necessary facilities and quarters will not be available during this period of temporary duty, the Finance Officer will pay the monetary allowances in lieu thereof, for such periods of travel as may be performed by rail, and the attention allowances prescribed in Table II, AR 35-4520, for one (1) man or twelve (12) days.

3. Reimbursement for the expenses incurred in connection with this travel will be made to the War Department by the Office of Strategic Services. The Finance Officer making payment in connection with the travel performed will submit a copy of the voucher showing the amount paid, month in which paid, voucher number and citation of this order by letter of transmittal to the Adjutant General's Office, attention Fiscal Section, stating that the enclosed copy of voucher is furnished for the purpose of securing reimbursement from the Office of Strategic Services.
