MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHIEF, SITUATION AND PLANNING BRANCH:

Subject: Information from Radio Sources other than
Federal Communications Commission.

CENTRAL EUROPE.

There appears to be traffic routed from Berlin to Prague to Tallinn Estonia to Guatemala City. Times and frequencies have been noted. It would appear that Berlin is using this method to establish communication with Central America. Certain characteristics might indicate that it is Gestapo business.

Germany.

As of this morning, there has been considerable rush traffic between D.F.C. Berlin and W.A.K. Kabul Afghanistan. Some of this traffic were cryptograms to the Skoda works in Kabul and to the Samati Bank. The Department of Commerce has no information on a Skoda plant in Kabul.

WESTERN HEMISPHERE.

Chilean radio traffic between Chile and Peru has greatly increased, especially between CEA2 in Santiago and stations in Lima.
