Progress made on FBQ Co Inc covering approximately sixty days and progress to be expected in next sixty days. Data on organization, equipment, tasks and present operation of FBQ Co Inc and steps taken to answer every future OSS need. Sample reports of important and secret intelligence already being gathered by FBQ Co Inc, reaction of MIS to same, and question on future routing of this information. Request for confirmation or clarification of assumed OSS radio plan and personal status is also included for the sake of greater future efficiency. Reasons for past resistances of other government agencies.
