NARRATIVE

Mrs. Anne K. Dally's retirement on 29 March 1982 brings to a close a long and productive career with the Agency which began on 4 September 1952. Anne began her career as a Secretary-Steno in the Operations Directorate, and within a year was assigned to her first overseas post-- [redacted] Her potential was quickly recognized, and after serving a short time as an Intel Assistant, she found her forte in administrative duties. She served as the Admin Assistant, to [redacted] before resigning her staff status to accompany her spouse abroad.

While accompanying Mr. Dally on his assignment in [redacted] Mrs. Dally was re-employed by the Agency as a contract employee. She maintained her contract status through Mr. Dally's next post of assignment [redacted]

Although she returned to the secretarial field to regain her staff status, her abilities soon led her to a professional assignment as a [redacted] Officer. As was characteristic, Anne threw herself into learning her new and varied responsibilities, being evaluated ultimately as an employee who frequently exceeded the work standards in performing her duties.

Just prior to her retirement, Mrs. Dally accepted an assignment [redacted] returning to the now familiar duties as an Administrative Assistant. Her record of performance gives testimony to her hard work and professionalism in reacquainting herself with this area of responsibility. Her final evaluation from [redacted] states that through her last days of service, her work gave no indication that a career was coming to a close. Mrs. Dally's Agency career covers a period of more than 27 years' service at Headquarters and in [redacted] countries, through which she consistently proved to be a hard-working, dedicated professional.
