Dear Mr. Hoover:

The information in your letter of November 23, 1953, and your memorandum of March 30, 1954, with respect to Mr. Frank G. Wisner of this Agency, has been reviewed. General Bedell Smith's letter in reply to your letter of 28 November 1953 gave the information available to us on this subject at that time and subsequent investigation has not disclosed any new relevant information.

It would appear from your memorandum of March 30, 1954, that Nicholae Malaxa and possibly certain other of the emigre Rumanians in this country have been responsible for spreading many vicious rumors.
