1. (SUMMARY. THE SEVEN-MAN DELEGATION OF THE JAPAN COMMITTEE INVESTIGATION OF WAR
CRIMES IN VIETNAM (JCIWCV) WHICH RECENTLY RETURNED FROM NORTH VIETNAM PLANS TO SUBMIT
EVIDENCE OF JAPANESE COLLABORATION WITH U.S. IN VIETNAM TO THE MARCH 1967 BERTRAND
RUSSELL WAR CRIMES TRIBUNAL. THE JCIWCV PLANS INCREASED ACTIVITY WHICH INCLUDES A
NEW WAVE OF ANTI-VIETNAM WAR ACTIVITY SPONSORED MAINLY BY JCIWCV AND THE AFRO-ASIAN
SOLIDARITY COMMITTEE (JAASC) WHICH CAN BE EXPECTED TO COMMENCE ON 6 FEBRUARY.

MILITARY ITEMS, SOME OF WHICH ARE PROBABLY OF JAPANESE ORIGIN. THE JCIWCV INTENDS TO ANALYSE THIS "EVIDENCE," PROVE THE JAPANESE ORIGIN OF SOME OF THE WAR ITEMS, AND THEN SUBMIT ITS ANALYSIS TO THE BERTRAND RUSSELL WAR CRIMES TRIBUNAL AS PROOF THAT THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT AND MONOPOLY CAPITAL ARE COLLABORATING WITH U.S. IMPERIALISM IN ITS AGGRESSION AGAINST THE PEOPLE OF VIETNAM. [REDACTED] COMMENT: KYODO WIRE SERVICE ON 21 JANUARY, REPORTING ON THE TOKYO AIRPORT PRESS CONFERENCE OF THE DELEGATION ON ITS ARRIVAL THE NIGHT OF 20 JANUARY, SAID THE DELEGATION DESCRIBED THE "EVIDENCE" AS NAPALM AND FRAGMENTATION ANTI-PERSONNEL BOMB SPLINTERS, ETC., WIDELY USED ON NON-MILITARY TARGETS AND CIVILIAN NONCOMBATANTS, BUT ADMITTED THAT THE DELEGATION HAD FAILED TO FIND CLEARLY MARKED "MADE IN JAPAN" MILITARY WEAPONS.)

3. JCIWCV ACTIVITY IN JAPAN IS NOW ON THE UPSWING, ESPECIALLY AFTER THIS SUCCESSFUL VISIT OF ITS DELEGATION TO NORTH VIETNAM. THE JCIWCV IS WELL ORGANIZED NOW, FUNCTIONING SMOOTHLY, AND EXPECTS TO PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN THE MARCH 1967 BERTRAND RUSSELL TRIBUNAL. THE JCIWCV FEELS THAT IT IS NOW FUNCTIONING MUCH BETTER THAN ITS EUROPEAN COUNTERPARTS. THE JCIWCV IS PLANNING A REPORT-BACK MEETING OF THE HANOI DELEGATION TO JCIWCV SUPPORTERS ON 6 FEBRUARY, THE ANNIVERSARY DATE OF THE BEGINNING OF THE U.S. BOMBING ATTACKS ON NORTH VIETNAM.

4. THE JCP FRONT JAPAN AFRO-ASIAN SOLIDARITY COMMITTEE (JAASC) PLANS TO HOLD MASS MEETINGS IN JAPAN ON 6 FEBRUARY AND 22 MARCH, THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE VIET CONG ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE FIVE-POINT STATEMENT ON ENDING THE WAR IN VIETNAM, AS EXPRESSIONS
