THE JAPAN COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE WAR CRIMES IN VIETNAM (JCIWCV) HAS DEFINITE PLANS FOR SPONSORING A SESSION OF THE BERTRAND RUSSELL "WAR CRIMES" TRIBUNAL TO BE HELD IN JAPAN IN 1967 AND TIMED TO COINCIDE WITH THE HIROSHIMA A-BOMB ANNIVERSARY ON 6 AUGUST. ITS INVITATIONS TO FOREIGN DIGNITARIES WILL INCLUDE SOME TO NORTH VIETNAMESE. THE JCIWCV, A JAPAN COMMUNIST PARTY FRONT ORGANIZATION, EXPECTS THAT THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT WILL REFUSE TO GRANT ENTRY VISAS TO THE NORTH VIETNAMESE, AND PLANS TO USE THIS FOR PROVOCATION AND PROPAGANDA PURPOSES DURING THIS JAPANESE SESSION OF THE TRIBUNAL
