2. BELGIAN TROTSKYIST ERNEST MANDEL HAD SENT A COPY OF THIS STATEMENT TO JACQUES GRIPPA, HEAD OF THE DISSIDENT PRO-CHINESE BELGIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCB. GRIPPA PARTY), URGING THE GRIPPA PARTY TO ASSOCIATE ITSELF WITH A BELGIAN COMMITTEE WHICH IS SUPPORTING THE STATEMENT. MANDEL CLAIMED THAT THE STATEMENT WAS BEING SUPPORTED BY NORTH VIETNAM PREMIER HO CHI MINH. [Redacted] SAID THAT A STUDY OF THE TEXT OF THE STATEMENT "WHICH WAS QUITE GOOD IN PARTS" REVEALED THE "STYLISTIC INFLUENCE" OF FIDEL CASTRO AND ACCORDING TO [Redacted] HE FELT IT WAS INTENDED ESPECIALLY TO PUT PRESSURE ON THE CHINESE GOVERNMENT TO WORK CLOSER WITH THE SOVIETS IN GIVING AID TO NORTH VIETNAM.
