GROUP, PREDICTED ON 8 MAY 1967 THAT NOT ONLY WOULD THE TRIBUNAL ^{SECRETARY} SECRETARIAT BE MOVED FROM LONDON TO PARIS, BUT THAT RALPH ^{GENERAL} SCHOENMAN WOULD BE OUT AS SECRETARY GENERAL. [Redacted] COMMENT: ACCORDING TO

[Redacted] SAID THAT NO DECISION HAD BEEN TAKEN AT THE CLOSED SESSION ON SUNDAY NIGHT 7 MAY REGARDING SCHOENMAN'S FUTURE AS TRIBUNAL SECRETARY GENERAL.)

BERGER STATED THAT THE FRENCH TRIBUNAL COMMITTEE WOULD NOT REPAY THE MONEY WHICH SCHOENMAN CLAIMS IT OWES THE BERTRAND RUSSELL PEACE FOUNDATION (BRPF) AND THAT, IN ANY CASE, THE FRENCH COMMITTEE DID NOT AGREE WITH THE FIGURES ADVANCED BY SCHOENMAN AS THE AMOUNT OF THE DEBT. [Redacted] COMMENT: IN [Redacted] [Redacted] REPORTED THAT THE TRIBUNAL OWED THE BRPF 100,000 DOLLARS PLUS THE COSTS OF THE FRENCH COMMITTEE WHICH WERE ADVANCED FROM THE BRPF. THE BRPF HAS NOW ASKED THAT THE FUNDS IT ADVANCED TO PARIS BE RETURNED.)
