RECENTLY A MEMBER OF THE SOVIET EMBASSY STAFF IN ROME CALLED ON [redacted] TO ENLIST HIS SUPPORT IN PLAYING DOWN THE PLANS OF BERTRAND RUSSELL TO SPONSOR A CONFERENCE TO CONDEMN THE SOVIET INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA. [redacted] COMMENT: IT WAS NOT CLEAR WHETHER THE SOVIET INTERVENED BEFORE OR AFTER THE 1-2 FEBRUARY STOCKHOLM CONFERENCE. [redacted] SO. RETURNED TO ROME ON 30 JANUARY FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE CAIRO AFRO-ASIAN PEOPLES SOLIDARITY ORGANIZATION.)

 STOCKHOLM CONFERENCE WAS ORGANIZED AS A SEPARATE ACTIVITY FROM
 THE PREVIOUS IWCT, FOR PURELY TACTICAL REASONS. AFTER THE
 NEAR EAST WAR, SOME ARAB STATES HAD REQUESTED THE IWCT TO INVESTIGATE
 WAR CRIMES IN THE NEAR EAST. HOWEVER, THE MEMBERS OF
 IWCT FOUND THEMSELVES AT VARIANCE IN THE ASSESSMENT OF THE NEAR
 EAST SITUATION AND THEREFORE THE REQUEST WAS TURNED DOWN. FOR
 THIS REASON IT WAS NOT DEEMED EXPEDIENT TO REVIVE THE IWCT AS
 SUCH TO CONDEMN THE CZECH OPPRESSION.
