3. ALTHOUGH THE TRIBUNAL HAD BEEN CONCEIVED ORIGINALLY TO INVESTIGATE ALLEGATIONS OF TORTURE AND POLITICAL REPRESSION IN BRAZIL, IT WAS THE UNANIMOUS DECISION OF THE PARTICIPANTS IN THE BRUSSELS MEETING THAT THE TRIBUNAL SHOULD EXTEND ITS INVESTIGATIONS TO CHILE AND OTHER LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES.

4. FRANCOIS RIGAUX, A PROFESSOR OF INTERNATIONAL LAW AT THE UNIVERSITY OF LOUVAIN, AND GEORGES ARONSTEIN, PRESIDENT OF THE BELGIAN LEAGUE FOR THE DEFENSE OF RIGHTS OF MAN, HAVE BEEN CHARGED WITH THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR CONTACTING VARIOUS INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANIZATIONS IN BELGIUM AND LUXEMBOURG TO OBTAIN THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE TRIBUNAL AND FOR KEEPING THE PUBLIC ADVISED OF ITS ACTIVITIES AND OBJECTIVES.

THE BRUSSELS MEETING WAS HELD MAINLY TO FORMALLY ESTABLISH THE SECOND TRIBUNAL, TO OBTAIN THE SUPPORT OF PROMINENT INDIVIDUALS OTHER THAN THOSE DESIGNATED BY THE BERTRAND RUSSELL PEACE FOUNDATION, AND TO DISCUSS WORKING PROCEDURES. A MORE SUBSTANTIVE DISCUSSION OF THE PROBLEMS INVOLVED IS PLANNED FOR THE NEXT SESSION OF THE SECOND RUSSELL TRIBUNAL, WHICH IS SCHEDULED TO BE HELD IN THE SPRING OF 1974 IN EITHER ROME OR BRUSSELS.
