SUBJECT: Commendation

1. As you are aware, the [redacted] of our Insurance and Casualty Division has recently been in contact with the next of kin of certain former Agency employees.

2. In the course of these contacts, certain of these next of kin have spoken very highly of representatives of the Office of Security who have been assisting them in their various problems. Two individuals have been specifically identified in this connection. They are Mr. Edmund K. Klipa and [redacted]. It was the feeling of these next of kin that both of these individuals performed services and rendered assistance far above and beyond any official duties that may have been imposed upon them.

3. In connection with this most recent incident, all of your [redacted] personnel have been referred to in the very finest way. However, these two individuals have been singled out and appear to be exceptional instances.

4. As you may also know, Mr. Klipa has provided very valuable assistance to representatives of the [redacted] [redacted] on previous occasions. This instance of recognition of his services is merely cumulative in nature.
