MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: John F. Herlihy
[redacted]

1. Both Messrs. Herlihy [redacted] requested TDY standby status in October 1968. They were contacted by [redacted] with regard to applying for a passport and identification card [redacted]. On 11 December 1969 [redacted] called to advise that neither employee has yet applied for his passport or identification card. [redacted] requested that we determine whether the documentation is still needed and if so, to have Messrs. Herlihy [redacted] contact [redacted]

2. Mr. Herlihy was called this date and he advised that both he [redacted] have been unable to find time to go to the [redacted] to apply. Mr. Herlihy has therefore requested that the applications for both he [redacted] be cancelled at this time. He stated that arrangements will have to be made at a later date if it becomes necessary for them to travel.

3. [redacted] was advised this date to cancel their applications.
