1. It is our recommendation that exception to [REDACTED] be made and Mr. Herlihy be promoted from CPC-6 to GS-7, Night Security Officer Trainee position.

2. It is noted that this individual was and is assigned at a lower grade and salary than that for which he is qualified. He entered on duty in March 1952 as a GS-4 coming to the Agency with approximately four years college and about two years clerical and auditing experience. Unfortunately he progressed very slowly, apparently through no fault of his own, as indicated by the memorandum dated 20 May 1953 signed by the Inspector General.

3. This candidate possesses characteristics suitable for an Investigator Trainee or Night Security Officer Trainee assignment. These characteristics, together with his experience prior to and since coming to the Agency including his assignment with us since October 1953, suggest that he compares favorably with candidates eligible for a GS-7 position. The Personnel Evaluation Reports on this individual since being with the Agency support the above contention.
