I hereby submit the following request under the Freedom of Information Act. Please consider this request separate and in addition to any previous request. This request does not supersede any prior request.

Records Requested

Every record held by the CIA on, about, concerning, or mentioning the city of Dearborn, MI. Some of the responsive records would be:

All research into threats where the city of Dearborn, Michigan is mentioned, all intercepted communication to, from, or mentioning the city or a person in Dearborn, Michigan, and any threat assessments on any person or group in Dearborn, Michigan. All intelligence gathered concerning possible suspects in Dearborn, MI.

News Media Fee Benefit and authorization of up to \$30 in fees

I am a member of the News Media as defined in 22CFR171.11(o) and request the applicable fee waiver. I do authorize up to \$30 in fees if this request is denied or fees are incurred further than the exemption allows. I do retain the right to appeal any denial of this request.

(o) Representative of the news media means any person actively gathering news for an entity that is organized and operated to publish or broadcast news to the public.

I write for and am gathering news for Witnesses Unto Me, a publication which distributes among other writing, news.

The term news means information that is about current events or that would be of current interest to the public.

My experience in journalism allows me judge the current interest of a topic to the public. I make this request with knowledge and belief the topic is of current interest to the public.

News media include television or radio stations broadcasting to the public at large and publishers of periodicals (but only in those instances when they can qualify as disseminators of "news") who make their products available for purchase by the general public.

Witnesses Unto Me disseminates many types of writing, including news. For an example of a recent news article, see "City of Dearborn limits free speech around Arab Festival" written by myself and published June 22, 2010 by Witnesses Unto Me. Witnesses Unto Me is available to the general public and is not limited to any subset of the public.

Freelance journalists may be regarded as working for a news organization if they can demonstrate, such as by past publication, a likelihood of publication through a representative of the news media, even though not actually employed by it.

My articles are frequently published by both Witnesses Unto Me and SBC Voices, the two publications for which I write. I am assured of publication as the publisher of Witnesses Unto Me and a regular columnist with SBC Voices.

In any situation where the fee will be the same or less, please provide documents in electronic format. Any electronic format is preferred to paper. Please use the most economical electronic format.


In case of denial
