Dear Coordinator:

Under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. subsection 552, I am requesting copies of all records on, about, or concerning the US Freeport gold mine in the Indonesian province of Papua. Limit responsive records to those created between January 1, 1990 and the date this request is processed.

The help identify responsive records, the mine is also known as the "Grasberg mine" and is owned by Freeport McMoran Copper and Gold Inc <FCX.N>.

In 2002, two American teachers were killed near the mine. In 2009, an Australian man was killed near the mine. In 2010 nine employees were fired upon and wounded. Responsive records should include all records on these incidents.

This is a news media request, please charge fees according to the news media fee category. I authorize up to \$30 in fees.

If you deny all or any part of this request, please cite each specific exemption you think justifies your refusal to release the information and notify me of appeal procedures available under the law.

Records are preferred in electronic format. Email is preferred, CD is also acceptable. Paper is only requested in a case where doing so would reduce my fee.
