



Provisional Electoral Council President Remy has [redacted] that the makeup election probably will be delayed until at least 6 August, with a runoff three weeks later. He cited logistic problems, such as the length of time it will take to print ballots.

— Remy said he is willing to step down, a major demand of opposition parties, but will not do so unless directed by someone with the authority to dismiss him. President Aristide is the only person who can remove Remy, and he has so far refused to do so, [redacted]

Remy has not offered any other concessions to the opposition, such as increasing the number of races to be rerun. In fact, local press reports say the Council yesterday disqualified 27 more candidates from participation in the runoff. Press accounts say 12 of those are from opposition groups or are independents; the others were not identified. The Council says it eliminated them because they were involved in the destruction of election materials.

— *Opposition parties are likely to view the disqualifications as a further reason to reject the election.* [redacted]



Lebanon: Strikers Seeking Showdown


Lebanon's largest labor organization began a one-day general strike this morning and called for public protests in defiance of a government ban on demonstrations, according to press reports. The unions are protesting recent tax and price hikes, including a 38-percent increase in the price of gasoline.

— Security personnel have been ordered to use force if necessary to uphold the ban on demonstrations, according to press reports. Hundreds of troops in tanks, armored personnel carriers, and trucks reportedly are deploying to main road junctions and government buildings.


