1. Cyprus-Turkey

a. The situation on the island remains extremely tense in the aftermath of Monday's shooting of two Greek officers and a Greek Cypriot.

b. Greek Cypriots are swearing vengeance, apparently not satisfied with the 31 or more Turkish Cypriot hostages they have already seized in retaliation. A number of these may have been put to death, and, if so, the whole affair promises to escalate when the Turkish Cypriots learn of it.

c. Greek Cypriots are concentrating in the Famagusta area and we expect violence there this weekend. Also in Limassol.

d. The Turks, [redacted] [redacted] are trying to infiltrate more fighters into Famagusta from Turkey.

f. Dissatisfaction over the government's handling of the Cyprus issue is widespread and a sense of frustration is building up [redacted]

## 3. Yemen-Aden





a. Tribesmen from the South Arabian Federation have been seen of late in "large numbers" on the streets of Taiz in Yemen.

Border Talks



a. The Soviets and Chinese have nothing to show for three months of negotiations over their mutual border.

5. Laos

a. The rightists are still pressing Souvanna to make substantial changes in his government. Adept at doing nothing, he has so far successfully resisted despite their threats to re-form a government on their own if he does not act promptly.

e. There has been no important change in the military situation. Nor do we yet have any hint of what the Communists intend to do, now that they have Tha Thom, beyond improving their military position before the rainy season sets in.




