B. KENYA - COMMUNIST CHINA: CHINESE COMMUNIST PROPAGANDA ACTIVITIES IN KENYA HAVE BACKFIRED. KENYATTA HAS THREATENED THE CHINESE AMBASSADOR WITH "DRASTIC ACTION" IF HE DOES NOT STOP CIRCULATING MATERIAL ATTACKING COUNTRIES WITH WHICH KENYA HAS FRIENDLY RELATIONS, SPECIFICALLY, THE US AND THE USSR. THE LOCAL PRESS HAS FOLLOWED UP WITH A FLOOD OF MATERIAL CRITICAL OF CHINESE COMMUNIST ACTIVITIES IN AFRICA.

C. BOLIVIA-US: BOLIVIAN STUDENTS YESTERDAY MADE THREE ROCK-THROWING ATTACKS ON THE USIA CENTER IN LA PAZ. A SMALL POLICE CONTINGENT WAS UNABLE TO CONTROL THE ATTACKERS. THE EMBASSY REPORTS ALL WINDOWS IN THE CENTER WERE SMASHED, AND THERE WAS MINOR DAMAGE TO FURNITURE, BUT NO INJURIES TO PERSONNEL.
