**THE PRESIDENT'S INTELLIGENCE CHECKLIST--2 JANUARY 1962****1. LAOS:**

A. BOUN OUM AND PHOUMI ARE EXPECTED TO INDICATE SOON, PROBABLY TODAY, WHETHER THEY ARE READY TO KEEP THE DOOR TO NEGOTIATIONS OPEN BY MAKING A CONCILIATORY RESPONSE TO SOUVANNA'S LAST OFFER. THEIR CHOICE IS BETWEEN NO REPLY AND ONE INDICATING WILLINGNESS TO CONCEDE THE DEFENSE AND INTERIOR MINISTRIES TO THE CENTER. AMBASSADOR BROWN, WHO HAS BEEN PRESSING HARD FOR A FAVORABLE REPLY, FEELS THAT THE US POSITION IS NOW FULLY UNDERSTOOD BY PHOUMI AND BOUN OUM, BUT NEVERTHELESS, EXPECTS THEM TO REFUSE SOUVANNA, AND THINKS OUR NEXT STEP WILL HAVE TO BE A VISIBLE INDICATION OF THE WITHDRAWAL OF US SUPPORT.

B. ON THE OTHER END, EFFORTS ARE BEING MADE TO PERSUADE SOUVANNA TO POSTPONE HIS DEPARTURE FOR PARIS SO THAT VIENTIANE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PLACE THE BURDEN FOR A FINAL RUPTURE ON HIM.

**2. NEW GUINEA ISSUE:**

A. PARLIAMENTARY AIRING OF THE ISSUE IS SCHEDULED TO OPEN IN THE HAGUE TODAY. THERE MAY BE A MOVE TO UNSEAT FOREIGN MINISTER LUNS BECAUSE OF HIS IDENTIFICATION WITH A RELATIVELY INFLEXIBLE POLICY, BUT THE GOVERNMENT MAY PLACATE THE OPPOSITION BY EXPRESSING ITS READINESS FOR NEGOTIATIONS.



B. DJAKARTA, MEANWHILE, IS CONCENTRATING ITS EFFORTS ON WINNING DIPLOMATIC SUPPORT, FOCUSING PARTICULARLY ON THE NON-ALIGNEDS.

C. THE USSR HAS PLEDGED ITS PROPAGANDA BACKING TO THE INDONESIANS, BUT SEEMS, NEVERTHELESS, TO BE COUNSELLING CAUTION.

3. PORTUGAL PUTS DOWN REBEL ATTEMPT:

A. THE SALAZAR REGIME QUICKLY SQUELCHED THE NEW YEARS DAY ATTEMPT BY A SMALL OPPOSITION BAND TO SEIZE AN ARMY BARRACKS IN SOUTHERN PORTUGAL AND IS NOW MOVING AGAINST OTHER OPPOSITION ELEMENTS. OUR EVIDENCE DOES NOT INDICATE THAT THE ATTEMPT WAS COMMUNIST-LED.

B. DESPITE THE REGIMES EARLY SUCCESS IN THIS INSTANCE, WE SEE THE POSSIBILITY OF MORE SERIOUS OUTBREAKS AHEAD. WITH THE INITIAL IMPACT OF THE GOA SHOCK BEGINNING TO DISSIPATE, REFORM-MINDED PORTUGUESE ARE NOW AWAITING SOME SIGN FROM SALAZAR, WHO IS SCHEDULED TO MAKE A MAJOR SPEECH ON WEDNESDAY, THAT HE IS READY TO MAKE DRASTIC CHANGES IN ORDER TO SOLVE HIS COLONIAL PROBLEM.

4. CONGO:

A. TSHOMBE HAS REJECTED PRESIDENT KASAVUBU'S CALL FOR THE CONVENING OF THE KATANGA ASSEMBLY AT UN-CONTROLLED KAMINA. HE SAYS, HOWEVER, THAT HE STILL PLANS TO HOLD AN ASSEMBLY MEETING, TO PASS ON HIS KITONA AGREEMENT WITH ADOULA, IN ELIZABETHVILLE ON WEDNESDAY. MEANWHILE, HE HAS PUBLICLY CONCEDED THAT HIS FORCES HAVE HAD TO GIVE GROUND IN NORTHERN KATANGA UNDER PRESSURE FROM CONGO ARMY FORCES.

B. IN STANLEYVILLE, GIZENGA'S POSITION SEEMS TO BE WANING SOMEWHAT. CAIRO HAS AGAIN URGED HIM TO RETURN TO LEOPOLDVILLE, CONTENDING THAT, OTHERWISE, HE WILL BE READ OUT OF THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT SOON. [REDACTED]

5. MOSCOW INTIMATES CONCERN OVER US POSITION ON BERLIN:

OUT A ROUND-UP OF MEMBERS OF THE RIGHT-WING SOCIAL NATIONAL PARTY  
WHICH TOUCHED OFF THE UPRISING

D. EGYPT, GHANA, GUINEA AND MOROCCO HAVE DECIDED TO ESTABLISH THE HEADQUARTERS OF THEIR JOINT DEFENSE ORGANIZATION, THE SO-CALLED AFRICAN HIGH COMMAND, IN ACCRA, UNDER AN EGYPTIAN CHIEF OF STAFF. THEY ARE AIMING AT A COMBINED FORCE OF SOME 20,000 MEN.

E. MOSCOW HAS SIGNIFIED HEIGHTENED INTEREST IN CAMBODIA BY APPOINTING A SEPARATE AMBASSADOR. PREVIOUSLY, IT HAD ONE AMBASSADOR ACCREDITED TO BOTH LAOS AND CAMBODIA. PHNOM PENH YESTERDAY MADE NEW CHARGES OF SOUTH VIETNAMESE BORDER INCURSIONS.
