<p>Reports arrival home from N.Y. 6 Aug 52 on NCPA president Hasan DOSTI and NCPA member Nuci KOTTA to take part in local meetings of leaders of parties represented in NCPA to discuss Committee reorganization. A plenary session held on 11 Aug 52 was attended by Hasan DOSTI, Caco GOGO, Abas KUPI, Nuci KOTTA, Zef PALI and Seid KRIBZU. During this meeting Hasan DOSTI spoke of his political activities in the US, and assured his listeners that the US and Great Britain do not extend any slightest support to Greek designs on Albanian territory. Seid KRIBZU and Nuci KOTTA, supported by Abas KUPI, then proposed that Bal be admitted to Committee membership. DOSTI and Zef PALI replied evasively and stated they would express their views only after consultation with other members of their Party.</p> <p>At a meeting of Balli Kombetar leaders a few days later the KRIBZU-KOTTA-KUPI proposal was discussed. Hasan DOSTI's favorable attitude towards admission of BKI to NCPA was opposed by the other Balli leaders. The question will be further discussed at a further NCPA meeting.</p> <p>The report then states that local Albanian anti-communist exile circles are of the opinion that Bal will not be invited to join the Committee, that Hasan DOSTI's support of BKI admission is limited to mere lip service, and that DOSTI's chief interest is that of protecting the favored personal and political positions of himself and his friends rather than that of strengthening the Albanian exile anti-Communist front.</p>
