 PARAPHRASE

On 22 Aug 50, at a meeting of 70 Albanian emigres at a restaurant in Rome, Ali KLISSURA stated:  
 "This meeting is a convention of the BK and is a continuation of the convention of Berat. We do not recognize the Balli Kombetar as a section of the International Agrarian Party. Those who compose this are responsible for changing the organization of BK into a political party and re-naming it the International Agrarian Party.  
 At the meeting in Naples (which took place long ago), attended by a few persons, the decision was made to rename the Balli Kombetar as International Agrarian Party, and Hasan DOSTI was named President of the Party and later President of Free Albania. These gentlemen made dictatorial decisions, without respecting the Constitution which is very democratic."  
 This speech was answered by many speakers and condemned Hasan DOSTI because he had made no reply to the many written requests of Balli members to call a convention.  
 Ali KLISSURA charged that at the convention of the International Agrarian Party in the USA, Hasan DOSTI declared publicly that Ali KRYEZIU and others are agents of Tito. "He ought not to have said this", continued KLISSURA "because KRYEZIU is a member of the Committee for Free Albania. If DOSTI was sure that KRYEZIU is an agent of TITO, then he ought not to have accepted his offer of cooperation, and KRYEZIU should have been executed for damaging national interests. What DOSTI said is untrue; his only purpose was to compromise KRYEZIU in international public opinion."
