1. Following below are our comments re the various sub-paragraphs of Paragraph 2/Reference A:

a. The turn-over of persons to the CASTABIA and/or REDCAP offices has been virtually nil in the past nine months or so. Such action is normally reported in the monthly progress reports. We therefore suggest that the last sentence of Paragraph 3 d/EQW 21572 be worded in general terms so as to reflect only the fact that this arrangement is in effect, rather than attempt to specify a certain number of referrals per month.

b. Re the activities/role of CAJERSKY, we suggest the following wording for an additional sub-paragraph to Paragraph 3 a/EQW 21572: The DTLINEN West German office (current location is indicated in Paragraph 1/EGBA 33265), which is now named Field Office West (Aussenstelle West), is staffed by four DTLINEN employees. This office supervises and guides the activities of a so-called speakers team, comprised of six to eight persons, who participate in speeches/public rallies/public film showings and similar activities under the overt sponsorship/attribution of CAJERSKY. CAJERSKY in turn generally arranges the aforementioned activities in concert/coordination with civic/social/fraternal/religious, etc. groups located in the local areas where the respective activities are conducted. The members of the speakers team are not DTLINEN employees, and are reimbursed for their efforts on a fee basis with funds which are derived from indigenous contributors in West Germany. DTLINEN's so-called Field Office West arranges from 60 to 90 of the aforementioned activities per month, attended by anywhere from 3,500 to 10,000 persons.

c. DTLINEN's support of AEVINIL is now limited almost entirely to participation in the annual leaflet operations conducted against the Soviet Army Spring and Fall maneuvers. There is therefore no need to revise the pertinent paragraphs citing this activity in EGOM 21572.

e. Our comments re funding cover are contained in Paragraph 2/Reference B.

f. DTLINEN has liaison with and/or distributes material for CAIROIT, LEPAGAN, LCCASSOCK, [] [] the DGB, CASK, the ADK, CAWASH, and AEVINIL.

j. Direct KUBARK exploitation of personnel with high KUTUBE potential is contemplated. A reference to that effect should be added to the KUTUBE Annex.
