1. [] LEARNED 10 JANUARY FROM GLOBKE ASSISTANT DR BACHMANN THAT CHANCELLERY IN RECEIPT BRLN SENAT LETTER SIGNED BRANDT WHICH REFERS TO ENQUETE REPORT AND ASKS FEDGOVT DECIDE FUTURE DTLINEN AND NEWHAM NOW THAT STEPHAN TRIAL OVER. LETTER RECEIVED ON/ABOUT 23 DECEMBER BUT NOT ACTED UPON EARLIER DUE HOLIDAYS.

2. [] INTERPRETS BRLN SENAT LETTER AS ATTEMPT PLACE DTLINEN MONKEY ON FEDGOVT BACK. LETTER COMES AS SURPRISE SINCE [] WAS TOLD BY [] THERE WOULD BE NO WRITTEN COMMUNICATION ON DTLINEN AND MATTER WOULD BE DISCUSSED AND SETTLED PERSONALLY BETWEEN THEM (SEE PARA II B, EGQA 95657).

3. WE TOLD [] KUBARK HAD NO INTENTION MEDIATE TUG-OF-WAR BETWEEN TWO GERMAN AGENCIES, BUT WE HAD RIGHT EXPECT WITHIN REASONABLE TIME SPECIFIC COORDINATED GERMAN RECOMMENDATIONS RE DTLINEN/NEWHAM BASED ON ASSUMPTION FAVORABLE OUTCOME VARIOUS TRIALS IN WHICH NEWHAM INVOLVED. [] AGREED.
