Subject : DTLINEN Accounting

1. Pursuant to your request, I have taken up the matter once more during my visit in Berlin on 2 December.

2. DTLINEN indeed keeps two sets of books:

- a. one set pertaining to DYCLAVIER type of operations, and
- b. one set of books pertaining to its overt activities.

Both sets of books were turned over to us and have been examined by our Frankfurt auditors. As I informed you previously, our auditors are preparing a comprehensive report on this matter.

3. I have asked DTRULER to suggest to DTLINEN that the DYCLAVIER books be retained in the DTRULER offices if this should be practicable. DTRULER will keep us advised as to the outcome of this matter.

4. Upon further consideration I believe that we do not have to worry too much about the double bookkeeping procedures. Since the German authorities have now officially been informed of our connections with DTLINEN as well as TEMBER, eventual "scoopers" could now be told that DTLINEN as well as TEMBER did receive their money from us and that they had accounted to us for their funds. Any information in regard to these funds should come from us.
