Attached is a KgU pamphlet passed to us by ZIPPER. It "fell to the ground from a balloon" in the vicinity of Alexanderplatz, East Berlin, exact time of recovery unknown (the ZIPPER source's report covered the period mid-February to 9 March 1954). According to the source the VOPO could not prevent the population from gathering the pamphlets.
