MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

At a meeting in the Presentation Room on December 7, 1951, attended by [redacted], [redacted], Greene, Wilbur and the undersigned, the following agreements were reached:

1. George H. Greene, Jr. would submit his resignation as President of CFA.
2. Alan Valentine would take over as President of CFA, in accordance with a plan to be worked out in San Francisco by Wilbur, Valentine and Greene.
3. Greene, Wilbur and Valentine would return to the CFA offices together on Monday, December 10, call a staff meeting, and announce the decisions to the staff.
4. A press release would be worked up by CFA, acceptable to us and State, and cleared by us and State prior to release.
5. Arrangements would be worked out by Col. Stilwell so that George H. Greene Jr. will be offered and accept a traveling fellowship for surveying the overseas Chinese communities for possible exploitation.
